Export Award goes to Elomatic

The Internationalisation Committee of the Turku Chamber of Commerce has awarded its 2014 Export Award to Elomatic. Elomatic employs over 700 employees in 8 countries. Elomatic's number of employees and turnover have been growing steadily for several years.

Elomatic was founded in 1970 and offers consulting, engineering, product development and project management as well as products and turnkey solutions to industrial and public sector companies. Elomatic has offices in Finland, Poland, India, China, Italy, Serbia, Russia and the UAE and customers in 80 countries.

Two thirds of Elomatic's projects are directly or indirectly export related, i.e. either the customer or the end user of the product or service is abroad. Elomatic has shown strong growth despite the difficult global economic situation. Between 2012 and 2014 Elomatic hired over 100 new employees and since 2010 its annual turnover growth rate has been 12,9%. Turnover for 2014 stood at 45,3 M€.

Elomatic's industrial know-how areas include biotech and pharmaceuticals, energy, machinery and equipment manufacturing, marine & offshore, oil & gas, process industries, as well as starch and potato processing. In addition to traditional engineering and consulting Elomatic also focuses strongly on products, concepts and turnkey deliveries.

2014 was a successful year for, among others, Elomatic's new flu gas scrubber business operations: two big Finnish energy companies decided to implement the energy and waste efficient solution provided by Elomatic's daughter company, Caligo Industria Oy. Good domestic references provide a solid foundation to start international marketing. In India Elomatic's Cadmatic 3D software was selected to design new nuclear power plants. The deal opens new opportunities in the nuclear sector and was also financially significant. A turnkey infusion solution plant delivered to Turkmenistan was started up smoothly and new similar plant deliveries are under negotiation. Projects related to increasing the environmental friendliness of shipping such as sulphur and ballast water treatment continue to provide work in Finland and abroad.

Seventh time

This is the seventh time the Turku Chamber of Commerce has awarded its Export Award. Companies that have previously won the award include Bayer Oy, Vahterus Oy, Treston Oy, Trafotek Oy, Ledil Oy, as well as Almaco Group. With the award the Turku Chamber of Commerce's Internationalisation Committee strives to shed light on companies in Southwest Finland that have achieved international success.
